

Buddha's Playground: Acoustic Music for the Soul

Katy Tsai and Bek Wermut

This is an album of beautifully meditative music upon which you can let your mind drift towards the infinite.



The nine different original compositions showcase the work of two young musicians from Sydney, Australia. Katy Tsai is a pianist and music teacher and Bek Wermut is music therapist and massage therapist who create live music for local mediation events.

In "Fishpond" the luminous tones of the harp (played by Bek) contrast with the counterpoint of Katy's log drum, while in "Reflections" Bek provides

a mixed percussion accompaniment to Katy's smoothly contemplative piano. In "Reminiscence" piano and harp play with a simple melodic theme, enjoying its permutations. "Playground" offers a lyrical vision of a halcyon childhood. Tibetan singing bowls round out the offering in "Coda" bringing the album to a contemplative conclusion.
